Mai Mountain, Jinan

Consist of Am Mai (Am means girl) Peak (686M) and Sut Mai (Sut means boy) Peak (679.9m). And it is a border between Mountains Sobaek and Mountains Noryeng. Two peaks have a shape of horse's ear, so it was named Mai Mountain, that means "horse ear". A slip road it worth seeing for a plenty of sakura (cherry) trees.



Deokjin Park

As one of 8 landscapes in Jeonju, visitors can see sights covered with lotus flowers blossoming lightly on the lake in half or so in summer. An actype suspension bridge in the center of the lkae welcomes visitors.

You can enjoy shopping with beautiful night sights due to being full of the seeing, the eating and the playing and installing the luminous, sightseeing light installment in the block of 360m.



Sunchang Spicy Soy Bean Paste Village

A real Village where Sunchang Company gathered workers who inherit traditional secrets of making soy bean paste. And it is a place where Spicy Soy Bean Paste is preparing with traditional taste.



Muju Insect Museum

This is the learning ground for ecology experience because visitors can see directly and observe the ecology on rare insects place to exterminate a stock and 13,500 insects in about 2000 stocks as well as fireflies.



Paper Museum

This museum has the relic remains and materials of about 18000 kinds related with paper and opens the special exhibition on various themes every year.



Namwon Theme Park

It's a tourist place based in Namwon City. Chyen District. The area is more than 100,000m. Movie director Im Gwon Taek took here his film "Chungyangdyon.



Keumsan Temple

This Buddhist Temple is situated at the foot of Moak Mountain in the forest. Since it has really ancient history, a lot of relics and precious things especially Mireukjeon, the 3 floor wood building that is the national precious #62.



National Jeonju Museum

It displays Buddhist arts, chinaware, metal craft, painting and writings, classical books, folk material and so on as well as antiquities excavated in Jeollabuk-do
